Since 1996, this Annual Asian Course in Temporal Bone / Ear Surgery take place in Bangkok, Thailand.

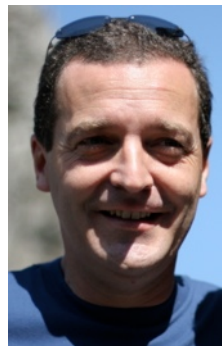

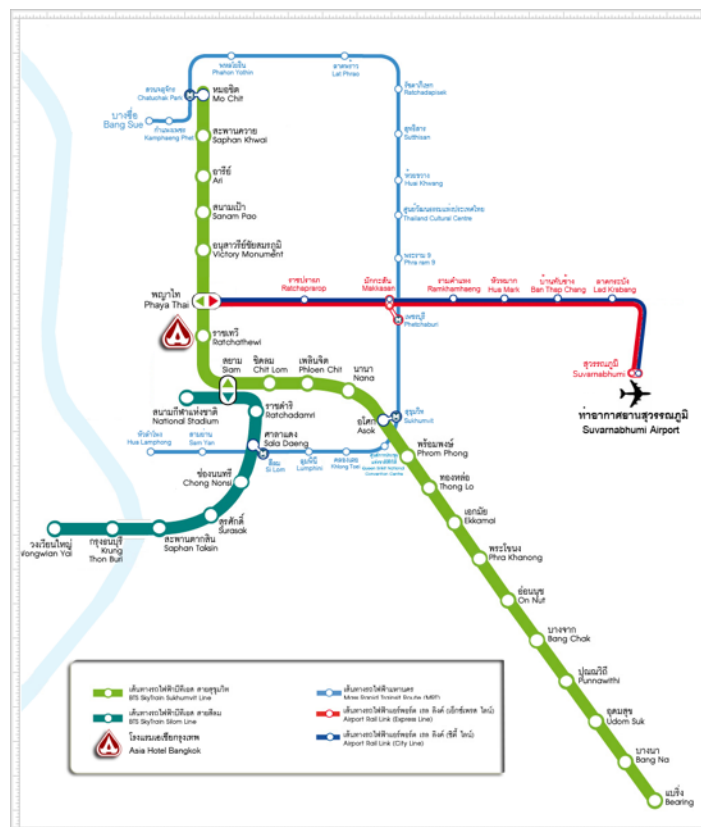

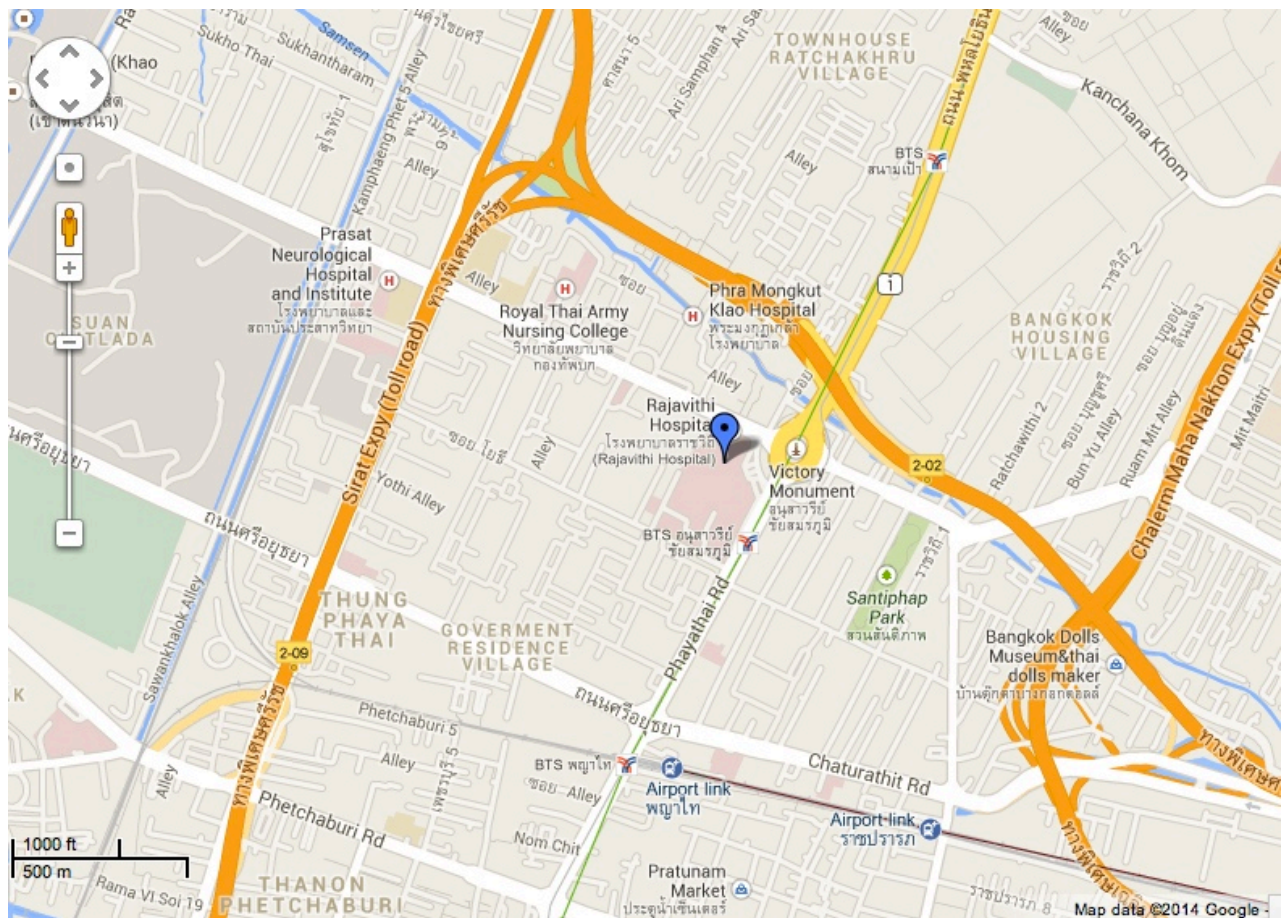
